



## Washing Machine - Soap Dispensers

Some of our customers are having difficulty determining the proper location for adding laundry products such as detergent, bleach, and softener. If you happen to be short (like me) and are using the larger machines, it's very difficult to see the top of the machines. The lids covering the dispensers are black, which makes it even more difficult to see which area to add your specific variety of laundry detergent. We have these signs posted on the walls and on each bulkhead at the laundromat.

The layout of the dispenser follows:

The front left opening is for pre-wash (powder or liquid detergent)

The front right is for normal wash (powder only)

The back left is for softener like downy (Liquid only)

The back right is for bleach (Liquid only)

So, if you happen to put detergent in the back left (softener dispenser) the detergent will not make it to your laundry until the rinse cycle and no one wants that. Basically, I'm going to use the front dispensers for powder, and the back for liquid. I hope this helps!
